



Resizing Images for Competitions/Evaluations Using Photoshop

- Open the Image in **Photoshop**.
- Under “**Image**” select “**Image Size.**”



- The Image Size Dialogue Box (PACN **maximum** image size for competitions and evaluations is 1920 pixels wide by 1080 pixels high.)



(Image resize dialogue box)

1. **Image Size** (Given in megabytes before and after resizing.)
2. **Dimensions:** the original size of the image is given here
3. Make sure that the width and length are **linked** in order to keep the proportions of your image constant.
4. Make sure that “**Resample**” is checked. Since the image is generally being made smaller, choose “**Bicubic Sharper.**”
5. Choose “**pixels**” as the unit of measurement.
6. **Resolution** doesn’t really matter but I generally set to 100 pixels/inch.
7. Begin by setting the width to 1080 pixels. The width will be reduced proportionately.
8. If the width **exceeds 1920 pixels**, change the image width to 1920 and allow the height to be reduced proportionately. You will seldom have an image match both 1080 and 1920
9. Click **OK**
10. Choose “**Save as**” to leave the original image untouched. Give your image a new name.
